Steps to becoming a WVPU student: In a few easy steps!

1. Create an account and submit your application:

Create an account on our website and fill in our application form. You can provide your required documents by uploading or emailing them to the Admissions Office: admissions@webster.ac.at

2. Admissions committee's decisions:

Once we have reviewed your application and confirmed you have met the criteria; you will receive an acceptance package. Sign and return your agreement to confirm your attendance.

3. Receive your acceptance package:

Your acceptance package will include guidance on everything from information on tuition fees, housing, and health insurance requirements.

4. Apply for a visa and arrange housing:

We will provide you with instructions in case you require an Austrian entry visa or student residence permit. In terms of housing, we offer a wide range of options tailored to your needs.

5. Register for classes:

Once the course registration opens, you will be able to sign up for your classes with the help of your academic advisor.

6. Willkommen in Wien:

Welcome to Vienna! Be sure you bring original documents listed in your acceptance letter.

Webster Vienna Private University accepts applicants year-round and we have two intakes per year (fall and spring). Students do not need to wait until their high school diploma is received. To prevent visa delays, students are strongly encouraged to apply for their visa as soon as they are accepted. The visa process may take 6 months or longer depending on the country of citizenship.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA) IN INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

Students learn to understand and explain a comprehensive range of international relations issues, how to do rigorous and structured research, and how to develop scholarly analysis as well as how to apply it. Our international classes, with students and faculty from all around the world, enhance different perspectives in political and cultural discussions, leading to a better understanding of intricate issues in the field of International Relations.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA) IN PSYCHOLOGY

Students learn how to access the unconscious mind, while being leg through all fundamental psychology sub-disciplines during their studies. Degree majors also have access to the CanBeLab (Cognitive & Affective Neuroscience and Behaviour) and the Observation Lab. Students also learn advanced research methods, such as the advanced analysis of statistical techniques, research methodology, and psychological testing.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (BSC) IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Designed for students seeking a strong foundation in overall business comprehension in today's competitive, global markets. The program covers the span of business-related disciplines including accounting, international business law, economics, finance, management, international business and information systems. BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA) IN STRATEGIC COMMUNICATION

This program emphasizes workforce readiness skills necessary for leadership positions in advertising, public relations, promotions, campaigns, corporate communication, and more. Graduates can expect to work in organizational and corporate communication, promotional campaigns, public relations, media consultation, digital messaging, social media, and more.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (BSC) IN COMPUTER SCIENCE

This newly launched program equips students with a strong foundation in algorithms, data structures, digital networks and communication skills, while fostering critical thinking and research abilities. Students will study aspects from cybersecurity—including threats, defenses, and professional tools—to artificial intelligence, emphasizing machine learning and problem-solving across industries. With exposure to faculty research and expert lectures, graduates emerge as independent thinkers ready for advanced study or careers in diverse sectors, prepared to design, protect and innovate within critical digital systems.
